

CALL TO ARTISTS

2010 ACC FALL ART EXHIBIT

EXHIBIT THEME: “EXPRESSIONS OF FAITH”

All artists who attend Alderwood Community Church are invited to apply to the 1st Annual ACC Art Exhibit. This year’s exhibit will be over 2 weekends.

CATEGORIES

Artisan entries may include the following:

- **Paintings**: Oil, acrylic, pastel, tempera, airbrush, gouache, encaustic, batik, fresco, and watercolor, etc.
- **Drawings**: Graphite, colored pencil, chalk, pen & ink, etc.
- **Calligraphy**
- **Photography**: Film, digital or altered images originating from film or digital camera.
- **Sculpture**: Three-dimensional art of any material.
- **Glass**: 2D and 3D works including hot, warm and cool glass
- **Prints**: relief, intaglio, mezzotint, lithography, serigraph, monoprint, etc.
- **Miniatures**: Including 2D & 3D works
- **Mixed Media & Collage**

GUIDELINES

- Artists 18 years and older who attend ACC, are welcome to participate.
- Artists may enter up to 3 art pieces. Contact the Visual Art Ministry to enter a body of work.
- All entries must be original and entirely the work of the artist.
- No copies, derivatives or reproductions will be accepted. Work cannot be based on copyrighted or previously published materials.
- All entries must be dry. No wet paint or varnishes.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

- 3D work may not exceed 70" x 30" x 30".
- Art to be hung must be wired and ready for hanging — no saw-tooth or metal hangers.
- Hanging textiles, rugs or quilts must have a sleeve for mounting. A hanging rod must be provided.
- Artists may request a display table for smaller pieces or a body of work. Artists may be asked to provide artist easels if submitting multiple works.

IMAGE SPECIFICATIONS

Photo images can be submitted with digital photos on a CD or with 35mm color prints. Image files must be saved as jpg. files.

Provide 1-2 images per piece submitted. Please submit a minimum of 2 images for 3D artworks.

Fill out a separate Application Form for EACH piece being submitted (unless part of a body of work). An Application form is provided with this Call to Artists packet. Information you need to provide with EACH image:

- Your Name, address, etc.
- Title of Work
- Category (painting, miniature, etc.)
- Size
- Medium

LIABILITY

Every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition and return of your artwork. Alderwood Community Church and its volunteers do not assume responsibility for any loss or damage that may be incurred during this process.

All work needs to be of a substantial enough nature to withstand the procedures of an art exhibit. We encourage artists to carry their own insurance.

Alderwood Community Church reserves the right to refuse any piece that does not meet framing or finishing criteria. Acceptance of all entries will be at the discretion of Alderwood’s Visual Art Ministry.
